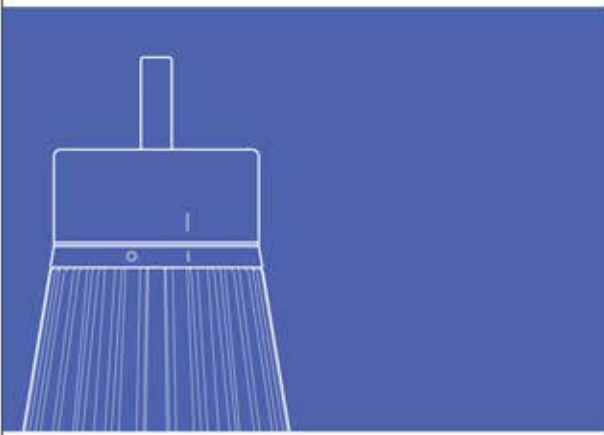
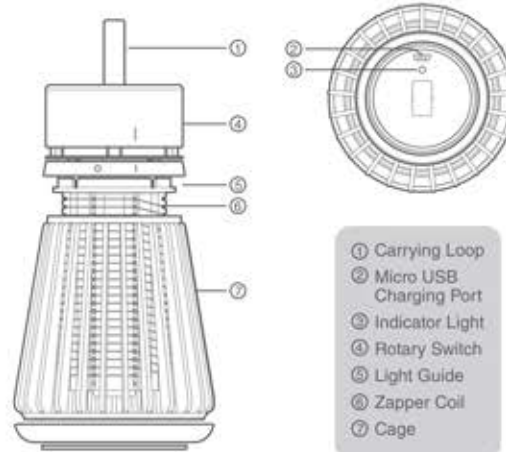

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

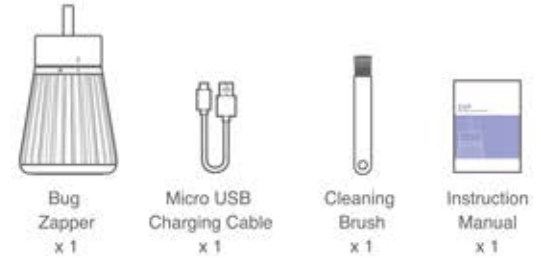


*Exploded view

PACKAGE CONTENTS



TIPS:

1. For best results, place Buzz B-Gone Zap in the space you wish to use and leave it operating for at least 2 hours. This will rid the area of any mosquitoes beforehand.
2. Rather than relying on poisonous chemicals, Buzz B-Gone Zap uses purple LEDs to lure mosquitos and other flying bugs to the zapper coil. As such, the device is most effective in dark conditions, with fewer light sources turned on.

DIRECTIONS

1. Make sure your device is fully charged before operating. When plugged in, the solid RED light means its charging. Solid GREEN light means it is fully charged.
2. To turn on the device, simply turn the top rotary switch clockwise. When fully turned you will here a 'click' and the purple LEDs will light up, the top LED indicator will also be lit solid GREEN.
3. Place or hang the device wherever you may need, and make sure it is upright.

CLEANING STEPS



1. Make sure the device is off before cleaning.
2. Use the brush provided to clean mosquitoes and debris from the electric grid. Empty the bottom shell into the trash and wash your hands thoroughly.
3. Avoid spraying any liquid cleaners and using metal objects to clean the device.
